The start of the 2024 golf season is fast approaching! The Ridgefield Golf Club Board of Governors has completed the Tournament Schedule and we are ready for another great season of fun, competition and prizes. **Please submit your Membership Application by March 15<sup>th</sup>.** The application and schedule are enclosed. Below are some important items for the upcoming year:

- Full Members, please renew ASAP.
- Handicap Members, please consider Full Membership. You can win the forty-dollar differential in one tournament.
- All rounds of golf played during the handicap season, not just rounds at the Ridgefield Golf Course, must be posted to GHIN. For rules about this, please go to our website, www.ridgefieldgolfclub.org.
- All participants in our tournaments need to play by the rules of golf and the rules of the particular tournament. The cardinal rule
  of golf is to play the ball as it lies, but please check the website and tournament sheet for updated local rules.
- The Kick-off Scramble is the first event of the year. Foursomes for this event are created by computer generated ABCD teams. This is a great event for new members to meet existing club members.
- Sign-up sheets for the two season-long events will be posted online the weekend the course opens. Please note that the Team Match Play will be played from the White Tees and the Tony Pisano Cup from the Blue Tees.
- The Board has decided to again donate \$500 to the First Tee of Connecticut to help grow the game of golf.
- In an attempt to grow our membership the Board has decided to continue the referral incentive program. This program provides a reduced membership fee to both the renewing member and the new member.
